Face-to-face Math and English Language Arts

Support with unfinished learning, Special Education, ELL, Gifted and Talented 5th grade students may have opportunity for virtual lessons in band or orchestra Opportunities for social and emotional learning

Learning at school days:

Hybrid will not receive all instruction through Teams

Time maximized with hybrid students

Teachers will cover 10 content lessons over a two-week spread for both Reading and Math

Learning at-home days:

Students have the option to join Teams meetings/lesson to review lessons - can also preview lessons

Students can use Canvas to guide independent practice and learning

Krysten thanked the PTA for help in getting started

Questions:

- **Q:** Will masks be provided? Have a number of disposable masks in case they are forgotten. Please bring masks. Masks and as much social distancing as possible will be the strongest mitigation strategies
- **Q:** Is there a preferred brand of mask? CDC recommends cloth or surgical disposable kind. Feel free to reach out to Mrs. Wlliams if any questions on a brand or type.
- **Q:** How will circle drop off and pick up work, if differently than normal? Drop off in front of school three different entrances from each age group.
- Q: What can we expect for notifications from the school if there are positive covid cases among students or staff? Mrs. Williams will call you directly if your child is a close contact a close contact is following Polk County Health if your child is in contact with < 6 ft for 15 minutes.
- Q: We've really enjoyed our virtual learning experience!! One thing we've missed is All School Sing. Any chance we'll be able to have a virtual option?
 - Will bring them soon working on the logistics to get them on calendars
- Q: Are we doing anything for presumed positives? I never tested positive, but I definitely had it for most of June. Are we requiring kids to stay home while they wait for tests? If you or anyone in your home has any symptoms, quarantine. Get tested if possible.
- **Q:** Any thoughts on second semester or when we would know of changes? No real timeline at this time want to get the kids back in the school as soon as is safe.
- **Q:** Are the screenings required and documented before coming in? Please check yourself and children Symptom screening tool is available on the Falcon File
- **Q: Drop-off by parking and walking to door?** Still possible but be mindful with masking and social distancing
- Q: Will pick up at the end of the day be in the back of the building for 9/10s this year? Pick up will be in front as each age group will come from different doors
- **Q:** Will the school accept donated wipes, etc? Mrs. Williams has an amazon list and will use SchoolCNXT for links for needed items. Generally, lysol spray is currently preferred to wipes
- **Q: Expectation to bring laptops everyday?** Yes, bring laptops back and forth, hopefully fully charged. Remember to also send the charger everyday.
- **Q:** Should we be getting school supplies for the class? The individual student? Should be good for now. Will send out the request if and when the need to there
