Questions -

<u>Parent teacher conferences gone?</u> No, still critical for DTS to have student-led conferences, it's core to our school experience. Mr. Burnett assumes the district will keep them.

<u>Field trips?</u> As vaccinations rollout and numbers decrease these opportunities will become available. Not currently allowed by DMPS School Board, but want to reinstate those once they get the go-ahead (e.g., attending shows at the Civic Center, etc.)

Heather Roe provided an update on her efforts to get the City of Des Moines to add more safety features to the intersection in front of DTS

Mostly "no" responses to Heather's requests, however the City engineer said he would order a couple of crosswalk signs with two pedestrians shown – expect the signs to go up in 6+ weeks

At a future PTA meeting, Mr. Burnett will share the City's plans for updating and reworking the intersection in front of DTS

Final numbers for bookfair are TBD, sold over \$600 of book but need to see what proceeds the school gets.
