 - b. Original Works

 - c. Adopt-A-Teacher
 - Thank you to all families that supported the fund this year before winter break.
 Funds from adopt-a-teacher help teachers purchase supplies that are unique to different classrooms and benefit students.

- III. Treasurer Report
 - a. Overall PTA funds
 - i. Expenses in the month of December were primarily for After School club and the school dance. We began December with a balance of \$15, 959.76 and ended with \$15,926.15.
 - b. Adopt-A-Teacher Funds

- i. This year, Downtown School parents donated \$2540 to the PTA's Adopt a Teacher Fund. This is the fund teachers can use for reimbursement of classroom expenses. The PTA also approved an additional \$2000 from PTA funds for teachers to use. This means most teachers will have \$206.36 available to them for the remainder of the year. There is an exception for 3/4 teachers given the upcoming departure of Ms. Wildman. Because there will be no replacement for Ms. Wildman and her students will be split among the other 3/4 classrooms, her \$206.36 will be split among the remaining 3/4 teachers so that those funds follow her students. Each 3/4 teacher will therefore have \$257.95 available to them. Thank you to everyone who donated! Your support really does make a difference for our teachers and our students.
- c. Original Works income
 - i. This fundraiser raised \$1,128.80. Thank you Tanya Keith for organizing and thank you to the families that purchased this year.
