- II. Barbara Hogan, School Counselor of 10+ years, new to DTS this year, presented on Social Emotional Learning (SEL)
  - A. See separate PowerPoint from Mrs. Hogan
  - B. SEL drives achievement outcomes
  - C. Collaborative for Academic, Social, and Emotional Learning: CASEL website https://casel.org/
  - D. Builds 5 competencies: Self-awareness, Self-management, Social awareness, Relationship skills, Responsible decision-making
  - E. Wayfinder is the name of the Curriculum we use (this is first year with this particular one), and this is just a part of SEL
    - 1. 10-20 minutes per week with teacher
      - a) Lesson plan example given
      - b) "This or that" game for self-awareness as example
    - 2. Core Counseling is in addition to Wayfinder
      - a) 30 minute lessons once a month delivered by Mrs. Hogan
      - b) Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS)
      - c) IEP is for disability, which is not suspected until at least 6 weeks of tier 3 intervention
